## BUILDING LAYOUTS

## Centennial Hall

- Rooms beginning with "1" are on the first floor, "2" on the second floor, "3" on the third floor, and "4" on the fourth floor
- Rooms ending with numbers between "05-14" are on the Sproles wing and numbers ending with "17$26 "$ are on the Barksdale wing. For example, 105 is on the first floor Sproles wing, and 124 is on the first floor Barksdale wing.
- The following rooms face the parking lot: 105, 107, 109, 111, 113, 122, 124, 205, 207, 209, 211, 213, 218, 220, 222, 224, 226, 305, 307, 309, 311, $313,318,320,322,324,326,405,407,409,411$, 413, 418, 420, 422, 424, 426.
- The following rooms face the courtyard: 106, 108, $110,112,114,119,121,123,206,208,210,212$, $214,217,219,221,223,225,306,308,310,312$, $314,317,319,321,323,325,406,408,410,412$, 414, 417, 419, 421, 423, 425.
- The " $A$ " bedroom is always next to the bathroom.

## Brookside

- The first number indicates the building in which the assignment is located. Buildings are numbered 1-7.
- The second number indicates the floor within the building on which the room is located ( 1,2 , or 3 ).
- The third number will be either $2,3,6$, or 7 and be followed by an "A" or "B". Matching numbers form a suite. For example 726A and 726B are connected to each other by the bathroom.
- All " $A$ " rooms are next to the exterior of the building and all "B" rooms are next to the lobby area of the building.
- Rooms ending in 33A, 33B, 37A, and 37B have an additional loft space in the room.


## Chipley Hall

- Rooms beginning with " 1 " are on the first floor, "2" on the second floor, and "3" on the third floor.
- The following numbers go together to form a full suite: 102/104, 103/105, 107/109, 110/112, 111/113, 115/117, 202/204, 203/205, 207/209, 210/212, 211/213, 214/216, 215/217, 218/220, 219/221, 302/304, 303/305, 307/309, 310/312, 311/313, 314/316, 315/317, 318/320, 319/321
- Rooms 106, 206, and 306 are considered ADA accessible and do not share a bathroom with another room.
- All odd numbered rooms face the circle in front of the building. All even numbered rooms face the library/plaza at the rear of the building.


## New Hall

- Rooms beginning with " 1 " are on the first floor, "2" on the second floor, and " 3 " on the third floor.
- Rooms 118, 120, 122, 124, 126, 157, 159, 161, 163, 165, 200, 202, 204, 206, 208, 210, 218, 222, 224, 226, 239, 241, 243, 245, 247, 249, 257, 259, 261, 263, 265, 300, $302,304,306,308,310,318,320,322$, $324,326,339,341,343,345,347,349$, 357, 359, 361, 363, 365 face the courtyard. All others face the driveway/parking area. No rooms have suitemates.


## Williamston

- The first number indicates the building in which the assignment is located. Buildings are numbered 1-8.
- The second number indicates the floor on which the room is located.
- Matching numbers with A/B form suites as do matching numbers with C/D. For example: 72A connects to 72B and 72C connects to 72D.
